What is CreativeCon?

Expanding and applying critical thinking, creative and alternative problem solving, and conversations on where and how creativity, arts, and STEM meet. Students attend three interactive breakout sessions led by professionals from the arts and sciences and have time to explore the Science Museum.

The day at CreativeCon

Your school or district will receive a random variety of tickets to the 10+ sessions. We encourage you to give students some choice about which sessions they will attend at CreativeCon.

Assure students that it will be easy to navigate to individual sessions they will attend. Chaperones, teachers, SBC staff and SBC's red-shirt volunteer crew are on hand to assist students with directions and questions during their day.
