What is the Creativity Festival?

Designed to challenge the creative minds of 3rd and 4th grade students, this one-day event celebrates multiple intelligences and provides experiences that encourage and develop creative thinking. Your students will learn from visual and performing artists, as well as professionals from the fields of science, technology, engineering, and math. A new group of presenters joins us each year and are announced in the fall.



The day at the Creativity Festival

During their day of attendance, students take part in three interactive breakout sessions and have the opportunity to experience a college campus. Your school or district will receive a variety of tickets to the 10+ sessions. We encourage giving students

some choice about which sessions they will attend at the Creativity Festival.

Assure students that it will be easy to navigate to individual sessions they will attend. Chaperones, teachers, SBC staff and SBC's red-shirt volunteer crew are on hand to assist students with directions and questions during their day at the Festival.
