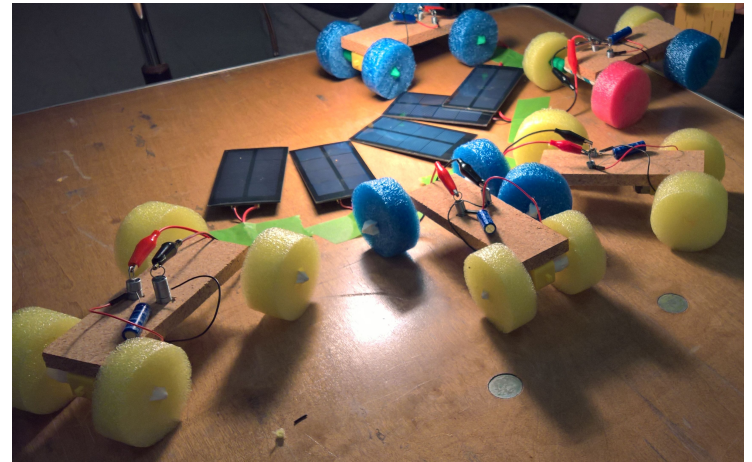

## What is the Creativity Festival?

At the Creativity Festival, 3rd through 5th graders learn that the ability to think creatively and problem solve is essential for all ages and in all areas of life. Each student experiences three unique interactive sessions highlighting the ways creativity and problem solving are applied in STEM, the arts, and across all careers. Students work with community professionals who demonstrate how creative thinking is used in their vocation and lives. Students learn that creativity is a life skill that can be practiced and strengthened.
